

## CRITERIA FOR FINANCIAL AID

UtahPresents provides private matinees for K-12 schools. Our multi-disciplinary programs bring diverse artistic and cultural experiences to our guests, exploring and enriching the human experience through the lens of creativity and the arts. As stewards of the iconic Kingsbury Hall, we provide a valuable gathering space that encourages curiosity, enhances cultural vibrancy, and creates connections beyond the stage.

Through the generosity of our donors, we can provide financial aid for our educational matinees to subsidize ticket fees and transportation costs.

To apply for aid, a school must meet at least one of the following qualifications:

- Classified as a Title 1 School
- A majority of the student population receives free or reduced lunch and/or receives SSI OR SSDI
- A majority of the student population is in Foster Care (under Utah or local governmental supervision)
- A majority of the student population is in State Custody Division of Child and Family Services or the Utah Juvenile Justice Department
- A majority of the student population receives McKinney-Vento
- A majority of the student population is from a rural district within Utah

Schools that meet one of the above qualifications are eligible for ticket fee reduction from \$4/student to \$2/student. Schools that meet two or more of the above qualifications may receive a full registration fee waiver.

Transportation assistance funds are available to educators to help cover transportation expenses. Schools may request a reimbursement of up to \$250 to cover transportation costs. This reimbursement is limited to once per academic year for each school.
